There are significant challenges facing humankind including the climate crisis, the COVID-19 pandemic, human rights violations and profound inequalities based on race, ethnicity, gender, age, disability, income, and other factors. Young people are at the forefront of movements for climate justice, social justice and human rights and are engaged in and beyond their local communities, working to create positive social change. This is a critical time in history. A lot depends on the willingness of adults to partner with children and young people, to dialogue and work together to address the challenges faced and to be more accountable to young people.

On the occasion of Human Rights Day, December 10th 2021, we are disseminating three videos, two short videos (3-4 minutes each) of young activists sharing **insights** and **advice** for adults on how to partner with them, plus a 28-minute **keynote speech** made by youth activist Nadine Clopton for UNA Sacramento, USA on UN Day, October 2021. Nadine presents compelling reasons for collaboration among generations to respond to climate injustice and social injustice, to learn from one another, to question and to find new ways to share, to re-imagine and co-create a world in which all living things are valued and cared for.

We encourage agencies and individuals supporting children and young people's participation and activism to watch and discuss these videos, to consider strategic and practical ways that you can strengthen your partnerships with and support for young activists. The young activists have given their permission for these videos to be used for awareness raising and training purposes.

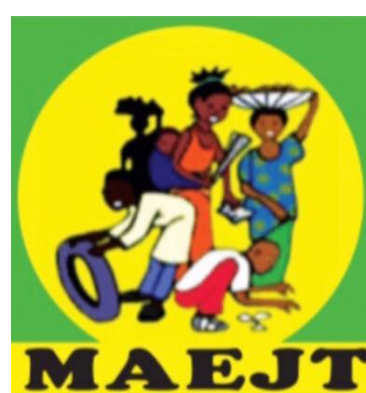
